This program is for businesses who will allow their employees to wear jeans to work in exchange for a donation to Shriners Hospitals for Children—Spokane Spine Surgery Fund. Shriners Hospitals for Children—Spokane will provide the business with stickers for their staff to wear on their shirts on the days they are in jeans to show they are “making a difference for the kids.”

All funds will be used to provide scoliosis surgery to children from our area who are on a surgery waiting list. The cost of the hardware ranges from \$8,000 to over \$20,000 in some cases, and all campaign donations will go directly to support this fund.
