DESCRIPTIONS OF MULTIMEDIA MATERIALS

Dreams Made Possible (2009, 24 min.)
Patient success video featuring Sage Warner and Mollie Carlson. Sage was diagnosed with a rare and severe form of scoliosis as a baby and has undergone several surgeries to straighten his spine. Sage is now an active 10-year-old who is an exceptional golfer, a Webelo in the Cub Scouts and an acoustic and electric guitar player. Mollie, 18, was born with a complete unilateral cleft lip and palate. After 19 reconstructive and cosmetic surgeries, she is now a confident and accomplished young woman who recently graduated as one of four valedictorians of her high school class.

**Defy the Odds (2008, 23 min.)**

Patient success video featuring David Grassi and Brian and Shana Howard. Seventeen-year-old David, an accomplished athlete, was born with spina bifida. Eighteen-year-old twins Brian and Shana sustained severe burns when they were 2. Shriners Hospitals have helped David, Brian and Shana defy the odds to pursue and reach their dreams.

**Hope for a Brighter Future (2007, 23 min.)**

Patient success video featuring Garrett Burgess and Leigh Dittman. Fourteen-year-old Garrett was in a car accident and sustained a high-level spinal cord injury when he was 4. Seven-year-old Leigh was born with osteogenesis imperfecta, also known as brittle bone disease. Participation in research studies at Shriners Hospitals, along with the expert care they receive there, have helped Leigh and Garrett enjoy more productive lives.

**Giving Back (2006, 23 min.)**

Patient success video featuring Shannon Kloppenburg and Megan Johnson. Eighteen-year-old Shannon has had more than 14 surgeries to repair the unilateral cleft lip and palate she was born with. Fifteen-year-old Megan was born with a severe case of hemifacial dysplasia, which resulted in a cleft lip palate. Both girls display an innate compassion for others – Shannon through volunteering and wanting to become a speech pathologist to help other children, and Megan by founding “Megan’s Mission,” through which she distributes blankets, socks and hats to Seattle’s homeless population.

**Challenge Me (2005, 24 min.)**

Patient success video featuring Sage Bollman and Katie Walker. At age 4, Sage became gravely ill with bacterial meningitis, and leg amputation led to prostheses. Shortly after birth, Katie underwent several surgeries to correct congenital abnormalities, which led to needing a prosthetic leg. Today, Sage is a happy, active 6-year-old, and Katie’s on her high school golf team and performs country music. Featured is Katie’s song “Challenge Me.”

**A New Beginning (2004, 23 min.)**

Patient success video featuring Timmy Kelly and Elena Evans. Timmy was born prematurely, and after numerous surgeries during infancy, he remained blind and was unable to walk. He was later diagnosed with cerebral palsy, but Shriners Hospitals helped him walk again. Timmy is a singer who has performed at many

prominent venues. Elena began her life in a Russian orphanage with a rare condition that left her feet deformed. She had her legs amputated so prostheses could be used. Elena is now an active 6-year-old who loves sports, especially hockey.

**Without Limits (2003, 21 min.)**

Patient success video featuring Myranda Schneider and Dan Caro. At age 2, Myranda’s foot got trapped beneath a lawnmower. An amputation was performed, and a prosthetic was needed. At 12 years old, she is a straight-A student and a softball player. At age 2, Dan Caro was badly burned by ignited gasoline fumes, and he received more than a decade of reconstructive surgeries at Shriners Hospitals. Dan, 22, now is a successful musician performing in his own band.

**Public Service Announcement (PSA) Campaign

**“Shriners...Having Fun & Helping Kids”  
Membership DVD (2006, 17 min.)**

An in-depth look at the fraternity and philanthropy, this program emphasizes the value of belonging to Shriners International. Hosted by actor and Shriner Richard Tyson, the video highlights a variety of activities and includes interviews with a wide assortment of nobles. The DVD is the perfect medium to reach potential Shriners and encourage them to join.

**Fit for the Future (2006, 90 min.)**

This program, created by Shriners Hospitals for Children and the FBI, includes three 20- to 30-minute upbeat, kid-friendly exercise routines for stretching, strengthening and stamina. The exercises can be done seated or standing, so it is appropriate for kids with and without disabilities. The video also addresses future employment for kids with disabilities.

This video is divided into five segments, focusing on: the Shriners International fraternity, the orthopaedic, burn and spinal cord injury care provided at Shriners Hospitals for Children, as well as Independence Square at the Philadelphia Shriners Hospital.
